Position's Primary Functions/Objective:

The program serves adolescent males and females, twelve to twenty-one years of age, who have committed a sexual offense.

Summary of Responsibilities:

- Intake: direct the orientation process with the new client
- Supervision: all aspects of treatment and discharge planning, monitoring case service plans.
- Group Therapy: facilitate and supervise offense specific group sessions, insure offense-specific curriculum is utilized and documented
- Family Therapy Services: insuring that clients received 1-3 hours of family therapy services per week, work flexible hours to accommodate family therapy needs
- Written Documents: maintain weekly progress notes
- Court Hearings: attend court hearing, foster care reviews and related meetings.
- Other duties as assigned.
